Are you ready to become leader for equity? Do you have the will and interest to enhance your leadership capacity and disrupt institutional policies/practices that handicap students of color in schools?

The Leading for Equity Institute will provide school leaders with a transformative experience designed to develop an understanding of equity issues. This institute will support participants as they act on their understanding to transform schools and classrooms into fair learning spaces for all students.

Participant Outcomes

- Explore their equity life journey and surface their implicit associations about race
- Define and create their definition of equity, and compare and contrast their definition to selected definitions found in the professional literature, and the straightforward or inferred definition of equity within their school, district and organization
- Engage in bold conversations on issues of race and equity, be supportive of each other on training problems related to equity issues associated with teaching and learning
- Use an equity audit to identify opportunities to lead for equity in their work contexts
- Identify opportunities to address differences related with existing inequalities as they develop their distinct and united capacity to lead for equity
