School Leadership

The School Leadership Institute is designed to support school leaders, including principals, assistant principals, administrators in improving their skills as instructional leaders. engage in a Community of Practice to improve their skills as instructional leaders. During the three-day training, participants will engage in a Community of Practice to:

- Explore and discuss current research in instructional leadership
- Create a plan to assign leadership roles among other staff members at their schools, so they can better manage their time and resources
- Examine the job-embedded professional development that is currently taking place at their schools and work together to explore more effective ways to meet the needs of their teachers and students

Participant Outcomes

- Explore and practice how to form robust conversations with all participants in the school
- Examine strategies that distribute leadership responsibilities while empowering teacher leaders
- Build their ability to have bold conversations with faculties that help all students learn
